Como es sabido, la organización de Stockyards Redevelopment suspendió sus operaciones a principios de este año. Los servicios de desarrollo comunitario para esas vecindades son ofrecidos actualmente por tres organizaciones: la oficina de de Stockyard, Clark-Fulton & Brooklyn Centre Community Development (SCFDO) que es satélite de Detroit Shoreway Community Development Organization (DSCDO), y Tremont West Development Corporation y Ohio City Near West Development Corporation. Además de los cambios en la entrega de servicios, estamos apoyando una estrategia para que las voces de la comunidad sean oídas, ahora y en el futuro, por concejales y representantes de DSCDO y SCFBC.

Se han venido celebrado varias reuniones de la comunidad en cada una de las vecindades atendidas por SCFBC. El objetivo de estas reuniones es crear los medios para que los residentes se unan, en forma constructiva y continua, con el fin de entender las necesidades de la comunidad, establecer prioridades y comunicarlas a los Centros de Desarrollo Comunitario (CDC) locales y concejales, para encontrar soluciones a ellas. En varias de las reuniones los residentes han expresado la importancia de aumentar la participación de la comunidad hispana.

Como líderes o miembros de la comunidad, esperamos sus comentarios sobre cómo podemos ser más efectivos en hacer sentir la voz de la comunidad hispana. Ustedes y sus organizaciones puede proveer información útil y esencial para involucrar a los inversionistas hispanos de estos vecindarios y proveer una perspectiva completa y valiosa de su compromiso con la comunidad.

As you may be aware, the Stockyards Redevelopment Organization ceased operations earlier this year. Community development services to these neighborhoods are now being provided by the Stockyard, Clark-Fulton & Brooklyn Centre Community Development Office (SCFBC), a satellite of the Detroit Shoreway Community Development Organization (DSCDO), as well as Tremont West Development Corporation and Ohio City Near West Development Corporation for those specific neighborhood areas. In addition to changes in service delivery, we are supporting the establishment of a community involvement strategy in order for community voices to be heard by Council representatives and DSCDO/SCFBC now and into the future.

A series of community meetings have been held within each of the neighborhoods served by SCFBC. The objective is to create the means for the residents of each of these neighborhoods to come together in a sustained and constructive manner for the purpose of understanding and prioritizing the local community development needs and communicating with their local CDC(s) and Councilmen on the means to meet these needs. At several of these meetings, residents have expressed the importance of increasing participation of the Hispanic community.

As a community leader, we seek your input as to how we can be more effective in raising the voice of the Hispanic community. You and your organization can provide essential information and feedback that can assist in reaching out to Hispanic stakeholders within these communities and provide a comprehensive and valuable perspective on community engagement.
