

TREMONT NETWORK VIDEO RECORDER (NVR) SYSTEM FOR SECURITY CAMERAS 2008 PILOT YEAR PROGRAM



What is the NVR?

The Tremont Network Video Recorder (NVR) is a computer-based video recorder designed to store and retrieve recordings from security cameras. The NVR is housed at Tremont West Development Corporation's offices. This device uses WebEye Alert NVR+ software to manage recordings and retrieve live and recording images via a web browser. The NVR can support up to 16 cameras and 10 days of recordings.

I've been hearing about this for months...is the system up and running yet?

Yes • The system's initial cameras have been installed and the recorder is functioning properly. The NVR system is ready to accept more participants.

Are there any rules and regulations?

You Bet • The NVR is administered by the Tremont West Safety Committee of the TWDC Board of Directors. Generally access is limited to the Safety Committee, Law enforcement and camera owners.

Do I purchase my own camera?

Yes • Your group or business is responsible for purchasing and installing the camera. TWDC does not provide or install the camera. Generally speaking, the Tremont NVR system supports cameras that range from \$250 to \$1,000.

Again, the camera must be installed before you or your group may connect to the Tremont NVR.

Okay...then what am I paying for?

Here's a brief list of the advantages of connecting to the Tremont NVR?

- The Tremont NVR system supports all major network cameras
- Users can access live and recorded images via the internet
- The Tremont NVR system can capture video and still images

This sounds great...how much does it cost?

- There's a one-time \$75 setup fee (which connects your camera to the system).
- We also charge a monthly maintenance fee of \$10 (per camera).
- Fees will be administered by TWDC.

*NOTE: This fee structure is for the 2008 Pilot Program only. Fees may be adjusted in 2009.
